-Dianne reported seeing hundreds of Eastern Pondhawks at Noxubee National Wildlife Refuge in northern Mississippi last week, along with another swarm of small dark dragonflies and a few damselflies.

-Emily- Research plans not set yet for Canada Darners and migration patterns. She said research in Canada would be more costly. Has MDS funded research before? Curt- MDS has gotten grants. MDS is a 501-c-3, so we can ask for donations. Emily can get funding to pay for Augsburg University student workers (not for summer 2021). Email to Emily if you want to help. Curt mentioned someone (Murray deMarch?) on MDS Facebook page (who is expert at ode identification), maybe from Canada, could be a contact for Emily.

-On diversity: Emily discussed the high student diversity at Augsburg Univ. It would be beneficial for MDS to work with them. Ron- Reach out to other universities too to partner. It's great that Emily publishes and credits MDS. Kat suggested CampFire organization for diversity and inclusion. Kurt suggested to plan for 2022 to partner with diverse organizations and groups.
